alāv [alāta-] *m.* fire lit in the open (as on winter nights).

pachār [cf. *pracchāt-] *f.* ‘falling on the back’ fainting fit.

pachār (*f.*) **khānā** *idiom.* ‘to fall on the back’ 1. to faint; 2. be beside oneself with agony.

kalejā thāmnā *idiom.* the heart to miss a beat.

kāmcor *m.* an idler.

fāqā [A] *m.* going without food.

fāqā honā *idiom.* a meal to be missed.

mārā-(mārā) phirnā *idiom.* ‘to wander around’ to live wretchedly.

naubat [AP] *f.* period, time, moment (of need).

cīthṛā *m.* rag.

qarz [A] *m.* debt.

vasūlī [AP] *f.* repayment of debts.

kalejī *f.* liver.

lapaknā [cf. *lappa-] *v.i.* to spring, to leap.

javābdehī [P] *f.* responsibility.

khof [A] *m.* fear, terror.

bhūnnā [cf. *bhrgna-] *v.t.* to roast, to parch, to bake.

ākāś-vṛtti [S] *f.* precarious existence.

sapūt [cf. suputra-] *m.* good, dutiful son.

nīmv [nemi-] *f.* foundation.

ghās chīlnā/kāṭnā *idiom.* to do sthg trivial or pointless.

gairat [AP] *f.* shame, self-respect.

dozakh [P] *m.* hell.

nirvyāj [S] *adj.* ‘without duplicity’ sincere, open.

fisād [A inf. n. of *fasd* ‘to be bad’] *m.* 1. corruptness; 2. disturbance, mischief, violence.

sōṭh [*śoṇṭhī-] *f.* dry ginger.

kutsit [S] *adj.* disreputable.

tasdīq [A تصدیق] *f.* testimony

caṭ karnā *idiom.* to eat up, to dissipate.

dīmg *f.* 1. boasting; 2 vanity.

dīmg mārnā *idiom.* to brag.

kulhaṛ [cf. /kulla-] *m.* an earthenware cup.

cullū [culu-] *m.* ‘palm of the hand hollowed’ handful.

sarganā [P] *m.* (ring)leader, chief.

taskīn [A] *f.* consolation, comfort.

phaṭe hāl *idiom.* in a bad shape.

jī-tor̄ *adj.* bone breaking.

nirīh [S] *adj.* innocent.

sabr [A] *m.* patience.

halaq [A حلق] *m.* throat, gullet.

khairiyat [AP] *f.* wellbeing.

bhoj [S] *m.* feast.

rasedār [] *adj.* ? tasty.

kifāyat [A. كفایة, inf. n. of 'to be sufficient' (for)] *f.* 1. sufficiency, adequacy; 2. plenty; 3. profit; 4. prudence.

paṭṭhā [*paṣṭha-] *m.* 1. a young but full-grown animal; 2. a vigorous young man.

genḍulī mārnā *idiom.* to coil oneself.

gāṛhī kamāī *idiom.* hard-won earnings.

piyakkar *adj.* drunkard.

maṭaknā [] *v.i.* to make flirtatious gestures.

bhinaknā *v.i.* to buzz.

lathpath [cf. H lithaṛnā] *adj.* soaked, drenched, smeared with.

lithaṛnā [] *v.i.* to be smeared or daubed.

mudā/muddāā [A عَدْ 'sthg claimed'] *m.* intention, wish; issue, matter.

tabāh [P] *adj.* ruined, wretched.

kuṛhnā [] *v.i.* to be disgusted.

ḍhimḍorā/ḍhāḍhorā *m.* drum.

ḍhimḍorā pīṭnā *idiom.* to proclaim, to announce publicly, to drum up (support).

bekas [P cf. kas 'who'] *adj.* friendless, destitute.

tāṛnā [tāḍayati] *v.t.* 1. to speculate about, to perceive; 2. to examine.

bazāz [A بازار bazzāz] *m.* cloth merchant, draper, mercer

jācnā [cf. H jāmcnā] *v.i.* 1. to be examined; 2. to seem good.

jāmcnā [yācyate] *v.t.* to examine.

asamañjas [S] *m.* hesitation.

cikhaunā/cakhautī [cf. H cakhnā] *m.* snack, a delicacy.

talnā [*talati] *v.t.* to fry.

kujjī *f.* unglazed earthenware cup.

tābaṛ-tor *adv.* 1. one after another, in quick succession; 2. in confusion.

surūr [A سورر] *m.* exhilaration.

dastūr [A] *m.* custom.

phūknā [*phūtka-] *v.t.* 1. to blow; 2. to squander (wealth).

kamar [P] *m.* waist.

khisaknā [] *v.i.* to slip away.

viśvās [S] *m.* trust.

ser [P] *adj.* full.

javābdehī [P] *f.* responsibility.

ḳhauf [P] *f.* fear.

tasdīq [A taṣdīq] *f.* confirming.
